

## **Prepress Checklist and Specifications**

Prepress refers to everything that happens to make sure a job is correctly prepared for printing. This is when you catch the errors that could hold up the job on press. For trouble-free printing down the line it is important to get your design in the best shape possible before upload.

- · Add 5mm bleed to jobs and 15mm for wrapping dibond panels.
- · Spell check entire document. Correct any errors in grammar and punctuation.
- · Check that important content is within safety margins.
- · Check overprint, ie white set to knockout not overprint.
- · Check that spot colors are converted to CMYK or, if desired, carefully defined and applied as spot.
- · Discard unused color swatches.
- · Make sure black body copy text is 100% Black only and not a CMYK Black.
- Large black areas should be rich black 60% Cyan, 40% Magenta, 40% Yellow and 100% Black.
- · Make sure there are no missing or inactive fonts.
- Check that fonts are styled in their "true" form (in other words, unaltered by artificial "bold" or "italics")
- · Tidy by deleting unused elements, elements on the pasteboard, and empty boxes.
- · Make sure that the template layer only contains template elements.
- · Template layer is set to non-printing or turned off.
- Artwork layer only contains artwork.
- · Create a color proof to check your document for color quality, spelling and layout.
- Supply a high res pdf with bleed and trims or a packaged file which includes all fonts and links.

## File set up for Procut/Die shape and white ink jobs.

When setting up these jobs it is important to get the following steps correct.

- Name layers as below,
- Through Cut for jobs cut to shape.
- · Kiss Cut for jobs that require a half slit tab.
- · Crease for jobs that require a fold.
- Spot 1 for jobs using white ink.
- · Artwork contains only the artwork on this layer.

Name the corresponding colour the same as the layer you wish to use and convert them to spot colours.
